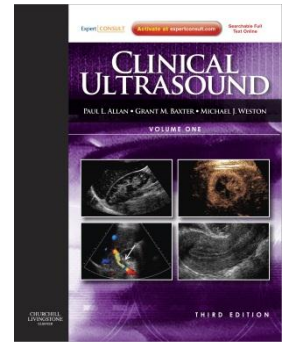

Since Donald's early pioneering studies, the development of ultrasound equipment has continued at a ferocious pace such that in the last 20 years or so it has become a routine part of the diagnostic armamentarium for doctors all round the world.

This comprehensive multi-author text covers the physics and basic principles of the technique with useful sections on artefacts and ultrasound safety. We are then taken on a comprehensive coverage of the ultrasound of the abdomen including the gallbladder, pancreas and kidneys. Gynaecological ultrasound is covered in some depth as would be expected. In addition, there are sections on head and neck ultrasound, ultrasound of the chest and the increasingly popular use in the musculoskeletal system.

Vascular ultrasound is also not given short shrift and there are even sections on paediatric aspects of ultrasound, including sections on scanning of the neonatal brain and infant spine as well as the paediatric abdomen.

All the chapters are comprehensively referenced and high quality images are included. The text is often complemented by diagrams and tables, making it an excellent reference volume.

Previous editions of this textbook have proved to be a great success and I am sure the current edition will continue with the fine tradition and, hopefully, will be well thumbed and regularly consulted by all radiologists and sonographers who perform ultrasound examination in their daily practice.
