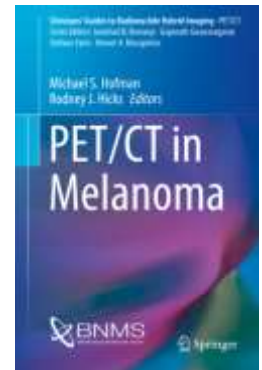


PET/CT in Melanoma

The title of the book is PET/CT in Melanoma. Of the 65 pages only half are attributed to PETCT. The rest is about melanoma and staging, pathology and management. All this information can be accessed elsewhere. The section on PETCT could take the form of an editorial, publication or review in a journal. To my mind, it is unnecessary padding. Having said that, I commend the authors for being up-to-date with the new eighth edition AJCC classification.

The small section on PETCT and additional teaching cases is instructional and informative to someone like me without a radiology background. Overall I do not feel the book is worth the cover price.
